Clock radios or alarm clocks

Curling irons, blow driers

Bus tokens, stored value bus fare cards

Prepaid phone calling cards, postage stamps

Gift certificates: (Target, Cub, Rainbow, Payless Shoes, haircuts, etc.)

For our street outreach team: bags of candy, first aid kits, personal care supplies, gift certificates For our teen parents: diapers, baby wipes, blankets, children's toys, etc.

Donated clothing should be limited to <u>new</u> t-shirts, socks, underwear, sweatshirts and sweat pants.
